Our national handicrafts include wood carving, pottery, jewelry, painting, miniatures, carving, and knife-making. In particular, the Uzbek knife-making craft has attracted the attention not only of the Arab people but also of all tourists visiting the festival. On the left side of the pavilion, there is Uzbek national cuisine. Even though the tandoor was specially brought from Uzbekistan to make delicious pies and somsa. It is important to note that in the Uzbek pavilion you can simultaneously watch a concert, eat and buy national handicrafts. This phenomenon can be observed in other countries as well. The festival showcased the true Islamic civilization of Sheikh Zayed, as well as the task of uniting the nations that unite the nations.
